Adventures in the Arts Registration Form

What: It's an opportunity for children to experience God's love, build friendships, discover new talents, be creative, and learn about the Word of God with a hands-on approach through music, drama, arts and crafts, and so much more! Each AiA meeting will include recreation time, music and art play, snack, and lots of fun!

Where: Christ Presbyterian Church, 1035 W. Granada Blvd, Ormond Beach, FL 32174-9169

When: **Wednesday afternoons beginning August 22**, after school dismisses until 4:30 p.m. We will be following the public school 2018-2019 calendar for early release or regular release days.

Who: Any child grades K-5

Cost: A contribution is requested of \$50 per child for the entire school year to help pay for snacks and supplies. (\$50 for first child, \$35 for 2nd, \$25 for 3rd child). We accept credit or debit payments in the office as well.

This is a separate program from 412 for middle and high school students. Please do not combine the fees paid.

Transportation: Participating children will be picked up at their respective schools (Pine Trail, Pathways, and Tomoka) and brought to the church. Be sure to tell your child's teacher they will be picked up by CPC on Wednesdays to avoid any confusion! *The registration and media release forms must be received before your child can be picked up from their school.*

- **Due to the limited number of seats on our bus, only the first 20 children from Pathways will be accepted.** Parents are welcome to drop their children off at the church instead of riding the bus. Please indicate on the form the preferred way for your child to be transported.
- **Completed registration forms, medical and signed media release forms, and payment must be in our hands or postmarked no later than August 20.**

What you should expect from us: Your child will be safe and cared for while having a fun time learning about relating to God and others during Adventures in the Arts.

What we expect from you: AiA is based on a curriculum that builds upon itself each week, so we ask that your children attend for the entire time to really gain the total experience AiA provides.

You must let the office know before Wednesday at noon if your child is going to be absent, if he/she will not be riding the bus, or with any other concerns.

Children must be picked up from CPC promptly at 4:30.

Good behavior is expected during AiA events and activities; parents will be notified of any misbehavior. In the event that these guidelines are not observed, each child/parent will receive a warning before any action is taken.
