For most of those years, the Memorial Garden has provided a place for the cremains of those beloved. We cherish the privilege of helping you and your family in their grief.

A key feature of the new Memorial Garden is the addition of columbaria to provide an improved final resting place for the cremains of our loved ones. Each niche will contain the cremains of either one or two, and the names and dates of death and birth will be engraved on the granite face for each niche.

This packet provides you with the information necessary to understand the process of acquiring a niche in the columbaria and what you can expect from us. It contains:

- A brochure featuring the new Memorial Garden itself and the opportunity to use pavers in the walkways to remember and honor those who have been and are important in your life.
- A brochure focusing on the columbaria that will be constructed in the Memorial Garden.
- The rules of the columbaria.
- An application for the purchase of a niche.
