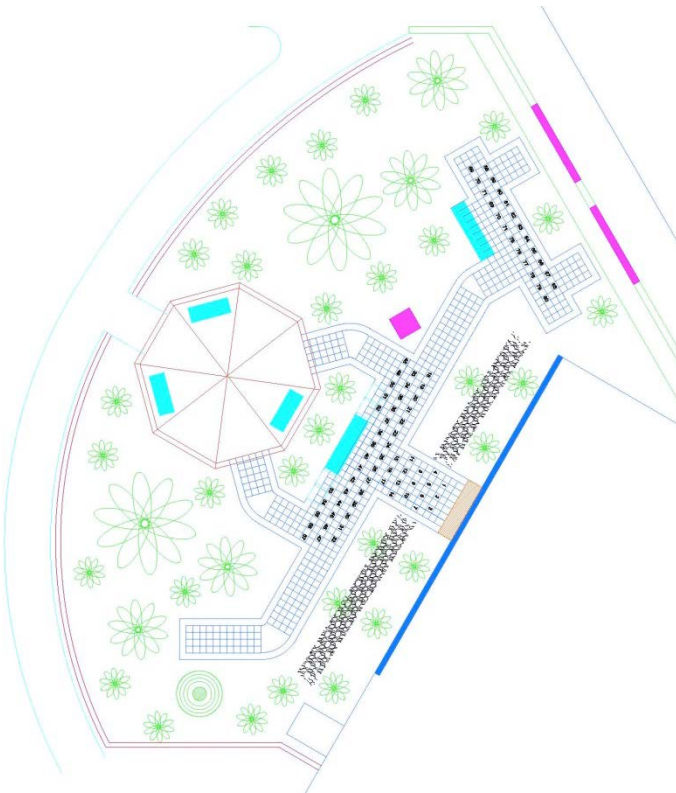


Memorial Garden Update

Progress is being made on our new Memorial Garden. The gazebo is in place. By the time you read this, the perimeter sidewalk may be finished.

A committee has begun to work on selecting plantings in the garden. Although it is still being formed, initially it includes Bill Hazard (Tree's husband), Barbara Walters, Georgia Harrington, Sandy Rossmeyer, Barbara Becker, Jack Williams, and Bob Marshall.

The interior of the garden will have brick paver walkways leading from the gazebo to the marble tablets where current cremains are interred, to the columbarium, and just around the garden. Interspersed with the brick pavers will be the engraved pavers that many of you purchased to remember or honor a loved one.



Most of those pavers will be near the columbarium. About a fourth, though, will be facing the marble tablets to remember those whose cremains are in the area or whose name is on one of the tablets.
